



INVITATION FOR YOUTH TO JOIN 2022 PEACE LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

The Tucson Youth and Peace Collective Team have opened applications for youth and young adults ages 12 to 24 to join their 2022 Youth Leadership Team and participate in a year-long peace leadership training program. Applications are open through May. This youth-led peace leadership program includes monthly stipend payments.

First Half of 2022: Dedicated to collaboratively designing, implementing, and participating in a peace leadership training program. This program includes planning and conducting a series of monthly events, activities, and actions focused on the three focus areas of the 10th Annual Youth and Peace Conference: equitable education, mental health & well-being, and strengthening youth voice, and monthly themes (e.g., March as Women's History Months, April as Sexual Assault Awareness Month, May as Mental Health Awareness Month, June as Pride Month). Monthly Stipends = \$50/month for 2022 Youth Team members from March to June.

Second Half of 2022: Dedicated to organizing and conducting the 11th Annual Youth and Peace Conference to take place in the fall. The Youth Leadership Team decides on the theme(s) and title for the conference, helps select workshops and plans dialogue circles, speakers, performers, and any special activities to highlight the chosen themes and title. This aspect of the Peace Leadership Training Program provides a valuable "hands on" experience organizing a major community event.

Monthly Stipends = Based on hours worked @ \$12/hour up to budget limit (ranging from \$180 - \$240/month)
